ORDINANCE # 2012-05
Union Township Fireworks Ordinance

SUMMARY: An Ordinance enacted to: define and regulate the time, place and manner for the use of Consumer Fire Works, Display Fireworks, and Articles Pyrotechnic; ban the use of Consumer Fireworks on days other than the day before, day of, and day after 10 specified National Holidays; requiring permits for public displays and pyrotechnic effects; provides for sanctions by civil infraction, fines and confiscation of evidence; effective 30 days after adoption.
