Our zoning ordinance gives this definition:



**3.1 ACCESSORY BUILDING (AMENDED, ORD 1997-11)**

A non-dwelling structure.

The ordinance further states:

**8.1 ACCESSORY BUILDINGS**

B. An accessory building may not be allowed when there is no principal building.

The township has constantly enforced this requirement. I regret to inform you that I will not issue a zoning permit for an accessory building without a principal structure.
