Charter Township of Union Interruption of Service and Boil Water Notice

A loss in pressure/service in the Charter Township of Union Water System in your area has occurred due to a water main break. In order to complete the repair, the water main was shut-off on July 30, 2020. This action caused a loss in pressure in the Charter Township of Union Water System in your area. Once water service is restored you will be required to boil your water before using. Bacterial contamination may occur in the water system. Residents and businesses, including food establishments, in the following area are affected:

2766 Weather wood Drive, 2767 Weather wood Drive, 2760 Weather wood Drive, 2761 Weather wood Drive, 2755 Weather wood Drive, 2754 Weather wood Drive, 2748 Weather wood Drive, 2749 Weather wood Drive

Bacteria are common throughout our environment and are not generally harmful. However, whenever a water system loses pressure for any significant length of time, *precautionary measures are recommended*.

DO NOT DRINK OR SERVE WATER WITHOUT BOILING IT FIRST. Bring all water to a boil, let it boil for five minutes, and let it cool before using, or use bottled water. Boiling kills bacteria and other organisms in the water. Boiled or bottled water should be used for drinking, making ice, coffee, pop or other beverages, and preparing food until further notice.

Food establishment operators should follow the instructions in the “Emergency Action Plans for Retail Food Establishments” guide. This document is available on the Michigan Department of Agriculture Web site at www.michigan.gov/michiganprepares. Instructions are available in English, Spanish, Arabic, and Chinese.

Water staff will take remedial actions such as flushing the water main and fire hydrants, and collecting bacteriological samples from the system to determine when the water meets the state drinking water standards. It’s estimated the problem will be resolved by **(Saturday August 1, 2020)**.

The boil water notice remains in effect until results from the sampling verify the water is safe to drink. **Another notice will be issued when the boil water advisory has been lifted. This notice will be posted on our website at www.uniontownshipmi.com.**
