Charter Township of Union Buildings Closures Expanded - Critical Service Delivery Only

In an effort to slow the spread of COVID-19, Union Township continues to follow recommendations of state and county health officials and the Center for Disease Control & Prevention (CDC), while still providing critical Township services.

Therefore, the closure of Township facilities to the public, which has been in effect since March 18, 2020, **will be continued until further notice**.

Beginning at **8:30 am on Tuesday, March 24 and until further notice**, the Township will only be providing critical services. This includes water and wastewater services. Other staff will be monitoring phones and emails and will attempt to respond to urgent inquiries.

We are closely monitoring the situation and will continue to communicate promptly in the event of any changes to this notice.
