Mr. Smith reviewed the financial statements. Financials are healthy, tax capture funds not distributed yet. Auditors are finishing up this week, everything looks good thus far.

MOTION by **Alwood** with SUPPORT by **Elmore** to receive and file the financial statements as presented. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

A. Elect EDA Secretary

Mr. Chowdhary volunteered for the position, and was nominated by Chairman Kequom. Mr. Kequom asked for any additional nominations, none were made and the Chair closed nominations. MOTION by **Perry** with SUPPORT by **Johnson** to elect Mr. Chowdhary as EDA Board Secretary. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

B. General Projects Update

Mr. Robinson reviewed the following projects:

Overpass Repair - Presented bid from Fussman Masonry in the amount of \$3,800 (NTE).

Discussion was held on the project: should take (3) days; will begin next week after issuance of right of way permit from MDOT; includes repair, check hollow points and seal coat. Moving forward, seal coat will be applied every (5) years.

MOTION by **Johnson** with SUPPORT by **Alwood** to approve repairs by Fussman Masonry as presented at a cost not to exceed \$3,800. MOTION CARRIED 8-0.

Christmas Lights (LED) – Mr. Robinson reviewed the contract for new LED lights, and asked for more time to do additional cost analysis on estimated savings.

Mr. Elmore asked that we consider an escape clause be added to the contract in case we are not happy with the lights.

Misc. Projects: Mowing - Wilson Lawn Care to start May 1st Banners - To be hung after May 15th Irrigation – Has started

Tree Removal Request - Mr. Robinson reviewed the request for tree (9) removal and alternative landscape plan submitted by University Motor Mall. The plan was determined to be very vague.

Discussion was held on the process and possible alternative landscaping plans. The Board asked that the administration go back to the original landscape design/engineering firm for advice on developing alternative plans.

Alternative resolutions were discussed, including allowing for (4) identified trees to be removed and replaced with landscaping. The Board determined that a professional landscaping plan would be required before action would be taken on the removal of any trees, and that it would be addressed at the May EDA meeting.

Board Comments: Mr. Perry reviewed the follow up meetings with the Drain Commissioner. Mr. Smith stated that all questions, concerns had been satisfactorily addressed.

Chairman Kequom adjourned meeting at 6:09 PM.
