2. The assessments in said Union Charter Township Special Assessment Roll No. 2015-01-SWK shall be divided into Ten (10) equal annual installments of principal with the first installment to be due on or before February 14, 2016 and the following installments to be due on or before the 14th day of the same month of each and every year thereafter.

All unpaid installments prior to their transfer to the tax roll as provided by Michigan Public Act 188 of 1954, as amended, shall bear interest payable annually on each installment due date at the rate of prime plus one percent per annum commencing on the first installment due date hereinbefore set forth. Any payments made within forty-five days (45) of completion of said project shall not bear any such interest.

Future due installments of an assessment against any parcel of land may be paid to the Township Treasurer at any time in full with interest accrued through the month in which the final installment is paid in accordance with the Michigan Public Act 188 of 1954, as amended. 





We have reviewed the bid received on Wednesday August 19, 2015 for the above referenced project. There was one (1) responsive bidder to the project and their base bid price is summarized as follows:

\$68,690.00

1. Isabella Corporation Inc.

The engineers estimate for this project originally generated in April was estimated at \$52,349. Review of the bid price reflects that the total project exceeds this estimate. There has been a noticeable increase (20 to 30%) in both the cost of materials and labor for the entire state of Michigan.

Gourdie-Fraser reviewed the estimated quantities and costs with the low bidder and has determined that a more cost effective solution is available. The bidder has proposed to install the sanitary forcemain by method of directional drilling as opposed to open cut which will provide a cost savings of \$8,340 equating to a total bid price of \$56,250.00

Using this information and based upon our past experiences with the Isabella Corporation, It is our recommendation to the board that they approve Isabella Corporation Inc. as the low bidder for the bid price amount of \$56,250.00. GFA will be providing all construction oversight including measurements of quantities and all adjustments will be addressed in the pay applications and a balancing change order at the end of the project.
