• Sign Ordinance

• Sustainability Report

Mikus updated the Board of Trustee's of what the Sustainability Committee has accomplished. The committee is made up of Lyon, Chowdary, Coffee, Lawrence, Rohrer, Mikus, and the township staff is Woody Woodruff, Samantha Fiani, and Brian Smith.

The recommendations and advice given to the Union Township Board of Trustees include energy conservation such as:

- Tracking energy conservation from Township Hall insulation, LED lights on Pickard, and other initiatives.
- Community garden project, which is in its second year by using of organic sprays and
 other barriers to prevent animal damage, initiation of user fee to encourage "ownership"
 and responsible clean up, water and hose service installed at the Jameson Park garden
 site.
- Multi-family (apartments) recycling, which has not materialized due to funding issues.
- Sidewalks on Bluegrass Rd and Isabella rd in an effort to design and install sidewalks which is expected to be completed this fall.
- The Green Self Assessment Check list for businesses and public facilities

• Union Township Environmental Leadership Award program which is under development.

Barker suggested the members of the joint meeting read the article in the paper which discussed the tax cut to the DDA.
