





On March 29, 2001, RVP Fiber Company, L.L.C., (RVP) filed an application, pursuant to the Michigan Telecommunications Act (MTA), MCL 484.2101 et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq., for a license to provide basic local exchange service in all exchanges currently served by Ameritech Michigan, Verizon North Inc., and Contel of the South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems.

At a hearing on June 19, 2001, RVP presented the testimony and exhibits of Barry Raterink, its President. The testimony of Margaret VanHasten of the Competitive Services Section of the Commission's Communications Division was also admitted into the record. Ms. VanHasten indicated that if the Commission grants the application, it should acknowledge certain regulatory

requirements specified in the MTA. At the close of the hearing, the parties waived compliance with the provisions of Section 81 of the Michigan Administrative Procedures Act, MCL 24.281; MSA 3.560(181).

After a review of the application and testimony, the Commission finds that approval of the application is in the public interest. On numerous occasions, the Commission has found that competition can be advantageous to the citizens of this state. Approval of the request for a license to provide basic local exchange service will expand the opportunities for competition. Accordingly, the application should be approved. The grant of a license is conditioned on full compliance with the provisions of the MTA, as well as the anti-slamming procedures adopted in Case

No. U-11900 and the number reclamation process adopted in Case No. U-12703. Failure to comply fully may result in revocation of the license or other penalties. Further, the grant of a license is conditioned upon the provision of service to customers within a reasonable time. Failure to do so may result in revocation of the license. Finally, the Commission notes that any numbers obtained by the applicant are a public resource and are not owned by the applicant. Consequently, if the applicant fails to provide service or goes out of business, any numbers assigned to it are subject to reclamation.

The Commission FINDS that:

a. Jurisdiction is pursuant to 1991 PA 179, as amended, MCL 484.2101 et seq.;

MSA 22.1469(101) et seq.; 1969 PA 306, as amended, MCL 24.201 et seq.; MSA 3.560(101)

et seq.; and the Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure, as amended, 1992 AACS,

R 460.17101 et seq.

b. RVP possesses sufficient technical, financial, and managerial resources and abilities to

provide basic local exchange service to all residential and commercial customers within the

geographic area of the license and intends to provide service within one year from the date of this

order.

c. Granting RVP a license to provide basic local exchange service in the requested areas will

not be contrary to the public interest.

THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that:

A. RVP Fiber Company, L.L.C., is granted a license to provide basic local exchange service in

all exchanges currently served by Ameritech Michigan, Verizon North Inc., and Contel of the

South, Inc., d/b/a Verizon North Systems.

B. RVP Fiber Company, L.L.C., shall provide basic local exchange service in accordance with

the regulatory requirements specified in the Michigan Telecommunications Act, MCL 484.2101

et seq.; MSA 22.1469(101) et seq., including the number portability provisions of Section 358, the

anti-slamming procedures adopted in Case No. U-11900, and the number reclamation process

adopted in Case No. U-12703.

C. Before commencing basic local exchange service, RVP Fiber Company, L.L.C., shall

submit its tariff reflecting the services that it will offer and identifying the exchanges in which it

will offer service.

The Commission reserves jurisdiction and may issue further orders as necessary.





BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Finance Approval

On November 6, 2018 the voters in the State of Michigan approved Proposal 2018-1. This proposal has already gone into effect. Proposal 2018-1 pertains to recreational Marihuana instead of medicinal Marihuana which was approved by voters in November of 2008. The Township cannot prohibit or regulate the use of Marihuana. The Township may only prohibit through an ordinance any or all types of recreational Marihuana establishments.

On December 19, 2018 Ord 2019-01 was introduced for a first reading to the Board of Trustees. During that meeting some discussion occurred but, no action was taken. The Ordinance has been modified to include an "Amendment" section to the Ordinance. The Township Board may amend or repeal at any time by Ordinance.

On February 27, 2019 the Board of Trustees re-introduced Ordinance 2019-01. After careful consideration and deliberation, the Board chose to hold a public hearing for the adoption of Ordinance 2019-01 on March 13, 2019. Notice of the public hearing was posted in the newspaper.

SCOPE OF SERVICES

This ordinance (attached) prohibits Marihuana establishments within the boundaries of the Charter Township of Union. It further provides the following:

- Provides penalties for violation of this ordinance.
- Provides for severability of this ordinance.
- Repeals all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith

JUSTIFICATION

The State of Michigan has one (1) year to establish a new regulatory system for potential Marihuana establishments. Not knowing what that regulatory system will be now this "Opt-Out" ordinance provides the Township time to evaluate whether to "Opt-In" once a regulatory system has been established. If a municipality does not have a prohibiting ordinance the State of Michigan will issue a license to qualifying recreational Marihuana facilities wishing to locate in the Township once the new regulatory system is established.

PROJECT TIME TABLE

The ordinance is first introduced to the Township Board for a 1st reading. The ordinance shall take effect 7 days after the notice of adoption has been published.

PROHIBITION OF MARIHUANA ESTABLISHMENTS ORDINANCE

An ordinance to provide a title for the ordinance; to define words; to prohibit marihuana establishments within the boundaries of the Charter Township of Union pursuant to Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL *et seq.*, as may be amended; to provide penalties for violation of this ordinance; to provide for severability; to repeal all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict therewith; Amendment process; and to provide an effective date.

THE CHARTER TOWNSHIP OF UNION ISABELLA COUNTY, MICHIGAN

ORDAINS:

SECTION I TITLE

This ordinance shall be known as and may be cited as the Charter Township of Union Prohibition of Marihuana Establishments Ordinance.

SECTION II DEFINITIONS

Words used herein shall have the definitions as provided for in Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL et seq., as may be amended.

SECTION III NO MARIHUANA ESTABLISMENTS

The Charter Township of Union hereby prohibits all Marihuana establishments within the boundaries of the Township pursuant to Initiated Law 1 of 2018, MCL et seq., as may be amended unless and until provision outlined in Section VII are effectuated.

SECTION IV VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES

- 1. Any person who disobeys neglects or refuses to comply with any provision of this ordinance or who causes allows or consents to any of the same shall be deemed to be responsible for the violation of this ordinance. A violation of this ordinance is deemed to be a nuisance per se.
- 2. A violation of this ordinance is a municipal civil infraction, for which the fines shall not be less than \$100 nor more than \$500, in the discretion of the Court. The foregoing sanctions shall be in addition to the rights of the Township to proceed at law or equity with other appropriate and proper remedies. Additionally, the violator shall pay costs which may include all expenses, direct and indirect, which the Township incurs in connection with the municipal civil infraction.
- 3. Each day during which any violation continues shall be deemed a separate offense.
- 4. In addition, the Township may seek injunctive relief against persons alleged to be in violation of this ordinance, and such other relief as may be provided by law.
- 5. This ordinance shall be administered and enforced by the Ordinance Enforcement Officer of the Township or by such other person (s) as designated by the Township Board from time to time.

SECTION V SEVERABLITY

The provisions of this ordinance are hereby declared to be severable. If any clause, sentence, word, section or provision is hereafter declared void or unenforceable for any reason by a court of competent jurisdiction, it shall not affect the remainder of such ordinance which shall continue in full force and effect.

SECTION VI REPEAL

All ordinance or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

SECTION VII AMENDMENT

The Township Board may amend or repeal this Ordinance at any time by Ordinance.

SECTION VIII EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect March 23, 2019.
